Dr. David O. Henderson, *Director*

David came to Edina from an active professional singing and private teaching schedule. He has appeared with many Twin Cities groups, including solo appearances with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, Minnesota Orchestra and the Plymouth Music Series (now Vocal Essence) Ensemble Singers. He came to the Twin Cities after singing for several years in New York with the Waverly Consort, Gregg Smith Singers and the Norman Luboff Choir. He received a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Minnesota. When not working at school he can often be seen with his wife Kris in their front yard in Edina playing with their three children, 10-year-old Ryan, 8-year-old Erin and 5-year-old Megan.

John Command, *Choreographer*

John returns to the Edina stage for his 20th Current Jam. His most recent work is as director of "Cabaret", "Company" and "Guys & Dolls" and "Hello, Dolly" starring Sally Struthers at Bloomington Civic Theater. He will return next year to do "Mame", "Sweeney Todd", "A Chorus Line" and "Damn Yankees". John's last musical at Edina was "Mame". Since then he has choreographed the 1988 Super Bowl Pre-Game Show, the Disney film "Newsies", "Sleepless in Seattle" and Prince's "Purple Rain". His television credits include "The Golden Girls", "Evening Shade", "Perfect Strangers", "Step By Step" and "Getting By". We are very happy to have John back at Edina and the students have enjoyed working with this talented choreographer.

Dr. Robert Ouren, *Back up Band Director*

Bob is currently an instrumental music instructor at the Fine Arts Interdisciplinary Resource (FAIR) School. He taught at Edina High School from 1991-2000. He earned his undergraduate degree from Winona State University and his Masters and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Minnesota. He studied conducting with Dr. Barry Kopetz and trumpet with Dr. Richard Lindner, Dr. David Baldwin and Gary Bordner of the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra. He is past president of the Minnesota chapter of the American School Band Directors Association, a former board member of the Minnesota Band Directors Association, and is currently a member of the Board of Directors of MMEA. He lives in Edina with his wife Karen, 21-year-old daughter, Karissa, and 16-year-old son, Matthew.

Scott Fahy, *Production Consultant*

Scott is responsible for the sound system, lighting design, videowall IMAG and the audio recording of Current Jam. Scott has worked with Sonic Flood, Rebecca St. James, The Bodeans, Widespread Panic, 10,000 Maniacs, Sounds of Blackness, Freddie Jones Band, CeCe Winans, Johnny Lang, John Michael Montgomery, Pam Tillis, The Blenders, Patti Loveless and numerous local and regional acts. He is president of OMNI Productions, a full service production management firm. He joined the Creative Productions Department at Living Word Christian Center in 2003. This is Scott's 16 year with **Current Jam**.

Diana J. Leland, *Varsity Choir Director*

Diana has taught choral music for a total of 31 years, including 27 years with the Edina Public Schools. She also serves as district Teaching and Learning specialist for the arts, theater and music. She returned to Edina High School from Valley View Middle School in September 1999 to direct the Varsity Choir. She has served as the general manager of the Dale Warland Singers, as well as state, division and national president of the American Choral Directors Association. She was named recipient of the F. Melius Christiansen Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Choral Directors Association of Minnesota. She also received the 2004 Arts Advocacy Leadership Arts Coordinator award from the Minnesota Alliance for Arts in Education.

Andy Thompson, *Arranger*

A 1998 graduate of Edina High School, Andy received his bachelor's degree in music composition from the University of Michigan. As a composer and arranger, his music has been performed by the University of Michigan Jazz Ensemble, and he has been commissioned by the Greater Twin Cities Youth Symphonies and the FAIR School in Crystal, MN. In addition, he has scored several award winning short and feature length films. As a multi-instrumentalist, he has performed with many local and national artists, including Dan Wilson (from Semisonic), Mike Doughty (from Soul Coughing), Atmosphere, Heirospecs, Robert Skoro and members of Nickel Creek. Andy plans to continue traveling the world writing and playing music.

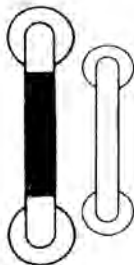

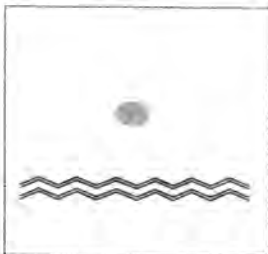

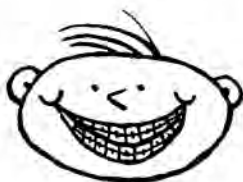
